**ANNUAL OCCUPANCY REPORT:** Enclosed with this newsletter is your annual occupancy report. All homeowners and landlords are **required by borough ordinance** to complete this form once a year. Please complete yours and return it to the borough office at 144 Lynnwood St. NO LATER than February 28.

Also, be aware that an occupancy **inspection** must be done **<u>each time</u>** a home is sold or there is a change in tenants – contact the borough office (412-824-6500) for the inspection form.

**TAX REDUCTION:** As you may know, we had to raise our millage by 1 point to 7.9 for 2010 because of increased sewer repair costs for last year. As anticipated, we were able to reduce our taxes back to 6.9 for 2011.

**CHALFANT VFC news**: As a fire prevention service to the residents of Chalfant, the Chalfant volunteer fire department is offering in home heat sensor camera inspections. The heat sensor camera will identify any hot spots that may become a problem or potentially cause a fire. Please note that the inspection is advisory only, and must be verified by a professional contractor. The fire department will also upon request perform a carbon monoxide inspection. We would like to ask for but do not require a donation for services. For more information please call the fire department @ 412-829-7415; leave a message and your call will be returned.

**GARBAGE COLLECTION:** The weeks of Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day we will have pickup one day late, on Thursday instead of Wednesday. Garbage pickup will NOT be affected following Easter Sunday, Christmas or New Year's Day. Please note that when a national holiday falls on a weekend day, our garbage collection is NOT delayed. We will have our regular Wednesday pickup the day before Thanksgiving.

Please do not put your cans out on the curb more than 24 hours in advance, and remove them within 24 hours of pick up.

## WINTER WEATHER:

- Remember that sidewalks must be shoveled within 24 hours of a snowfall.
- When shoveling your sidewalk or driveway, DO NOT shovel the snow into the street.
- Also, in the event of a significant snowfall, <u>if you have a driveway</u>, <u>please park there</u>, so snowplows can more effectively clear our streets.

Pauline Hardek was the first, from 1964-67; followed by Dolores Repic, 1973-76; Dorrie Seko, 1976-78; Diane Kostic, 1980-86; Trudy Martin, 1992; Laurie Williams, 1997-Present; Andree Ruth, 2003-06; Luann Orosz, 2006-08; and our 113th person is Annette Simek, 2010 - Present. Laurie Williams is our current President of Council, and is the only woman to hold that position.
